Are you a superstitious person? Do you avoid stepping on sidewalk font the cracks? Are you fearful of walking Partor under a ladder? Do you avoid using the number 13? There are lots of

different superstitions that people have. Some are cultural; some religious. Almost all of them are based on irrational fears of the unknown. We all want to feel like we are in control. That's why some people will go so far as to waste money on mediums, palm readers and psychics.

Superstitious beliefs and practices can also creep into our religion. If you've ever been told to say a certain prayer a certain number of times in order to obtain a favor from God, you are dealing with superstition. If you heard that you should bury a statute of St. Joseph upside down in order to sell your home, you are dealing with superstition. Praying through the intercession of St. Joseph that your home find a buyer is OK. But once you attribute some divine favor coming from a religious object you are bordering on superstition.

Our faith needs to be well-placed, informed and mature. We are not pagans who employ all kinds of home-made rituals in order to sway God in one way or the other. These thing are meaningless to God. What moves God's heart is our prayer and trust. We simply trust God to provide what we need without having to resort to all kinds of silly practices which find no basis in the Scriptures or in the ongoing Tradition of the Church.

So, go ahead and walk on those sidewalk cracks and feel free to pet a black cat and don't be worried about having fun on Friday the 13th. There is no power greater than God's ability to care for us and provide for us.
