**Mass Intentions**

As you may know, the spiritual fruits of each Mass may be offered up for the intentions of the living and deceased. It is also required that one Sunday (weekend) Mass be offered for all our parishioners. Canon Law dictates that a priest cannot accept more Mass intentions than he is able to fulfill in one year. Therefore, we cannot accept Mass intentions beyond one year's time from the current date. **In order to accommodate the many requests we receive for Mass intentions, we will now limit the number of Masses an individual requests (for the same person) to three (3) per year.** Another option is that we can take Mass intentions and give them to another priest in or out of the area who will celebrate Mass for that particular intention. However, we cannot guarantee a specific date. Finally, the customary "donation" for a Mass intention is \$10. But this is not mandatory.
